## **REQUIRED BOOKS**

1. The Time Keeper by Mitch Albom

- Did Albom create a realistic portrayal of a teenage girl with the character named Sarah? Explain your answer.
- What is your favorite line in the book? Explain your answer.
- 2. The Glass Menagerie by Tennessee Williams
  - The title of the play is the play's most prominent symbol. Explain the meaning of the title.
  - Identify two other symbols used in the play and explain each symbol. Highlight symbols in the text of the play. Use a yellow highlighter.
- 3. Same Kind of Different as Me by Ron Hall and Denver Moore
  - The following statements are examples of themes in the novel. Select two of the following themes and find a passage in the novel which deals with each theme. Write the theme in the margin next to the highlighted text. Use a yellow highlighter.

    - Homelessness
